# **COTRH COMPLETE DOCTRINAL STATEMENT**

## **About the Bible**

The Holy Scriptures, comprised of Old and New Testaments, are fully and verbally inspired by God and are therefore infallible and trustworthy in all areas in which they speak. Their central salvation message and essential teachings are clear and accessible to all who follow the standard and self-evident rules of literary interpretation. They are therefore the supreme, unmediated, and final authority of faith and practice for every believer.

## **About God**

There is only one eternal, almighty and perfect God. Within the Being of this one true God exist three Persons, eternally distinct and yet equally God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three Persons are the one true God.
